The Southern Development Region (SDR) is located in the southern part of the Republic of Moldova. The Prut River forms a natural border in the western part of the region, while the Dniester River largely marks the eastern border. In the extreme southwest, the SDR includes a small portion, approximately 400 m, of the left bank of the Danube. The area of the region is 7,379 km<sup>2</sup>, which represents almost a quarter (24.2%) of the territory of the Republic of Moldova.</p> <p>The South Development Region borders the Central Development Region to the north, the Transnistria Region to the northeast, Ukraine to the east and south, and Romania to the west.</p> <p>The Southern Development Region includes eight districts: Basarabeasca, Cahul, Cantemir, Causeni, Cimișlia, Leova, Ștefan Vodă and Taraclia. A specific feature of the region's location is that of the eight districts of the Southern DR, six are interspersed with the districts of the Autonomous Territorial Unit of Gagauzia.</p> <p>The region includes 294 localities. Eleven of them are cities, including eight district centers, with the same name as the district, and three smaller cities: Căinari, Iargara and Tvardița. The administrative center of the region is the city of Cimișlia.</p> <p>Compared to other development regions and national averages, the Southern Development Region has the lowest degree of industrialization. Land is one of the main natural resources, with agricultural land accounting for 74% of the total land area.</p> |



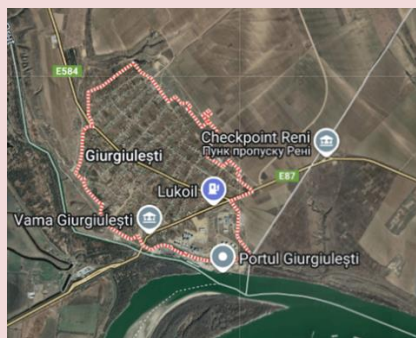
